

# PHOTO RADAR TICKETS

A dated response timeframe is now assigned to photo radar tickets. The new change affects the following three options:

1. Pay the fine indicated
2. Admit the offence but seek a reduction in the fine or an extension in the time to pay
3. Dispute the charge and request a hearing

If the driver does not respond within the specified time frame, a default conviction will be entered against them and a \$50 default conviction penalty will be added to the fine. They will no longer have options 2 and 3 available to them.

Due to the time frame for response, VEMA will now be emailing a copy of the offence notice to the Vehicle Coordinator. The original will be kept at VEMA. Should the driver wish to dispute the charge and request a hearing, the driver will need to contact VEMA to make arrangements for authorization prior to attending the provincial courts.

NOTE: The original ticket is not required if the driver chooses to pay the fine.
